

Queensland Government Building and Construction Training Policy (Training Policy)

This project has been selected as an **Indigenous Project** under the Training Policy.

For Indigenous projects, it is a priority that the core requirements (10 per cent of the total labour hours or 15% for projects \$100 million or greater) of the Training Policy be met by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander apprentices and trainees and local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander workers.

In addition to this, the Training Policy requires that an additional amount, equivalent to a further 10 per cent of the total labour hours (which equates to a minimum of 3 per cent of the estimated project value (including GST) for building projects and a minimum of 1.5 per cent of the estimated project value (including GST) for civil construction projects), be allocated toward an agreed Indigenous Economic Opportunities (IEO) Plan.

The Indigenous Economic Opportunities (IEO) Overview is a project specific guide that provides tenderer(s) with information about the Indigenous employment, training and business supply that is available in the area.

The IEO Overview is developed by the Principal (Government Agency) in consultation with the Department of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnership (DATSIP), Economic Participation Division.

Information for Tenderers

Tenderers are encouraged to undertake their own investigations in relation to the information provided in this IEO Overview.

When engaging with local trade or sub-contractors/suppliers identified from the IEO Overview, contractors should undertake invitation, evaluation and acceptance processes with such entities in a proper and formal manner just like any other contractor or supplier (i.e. a formal offer and acceptance process with an agreed / clear scope of works is expected).

The Principal (Government Agency/Government owned corporations) will use the IEO Overview to support post-tender negotiations. Post-tender negotiations include forming agreement on the IEO Plan between the DATSIP, the preferred tenderer (s) and the Principal.
